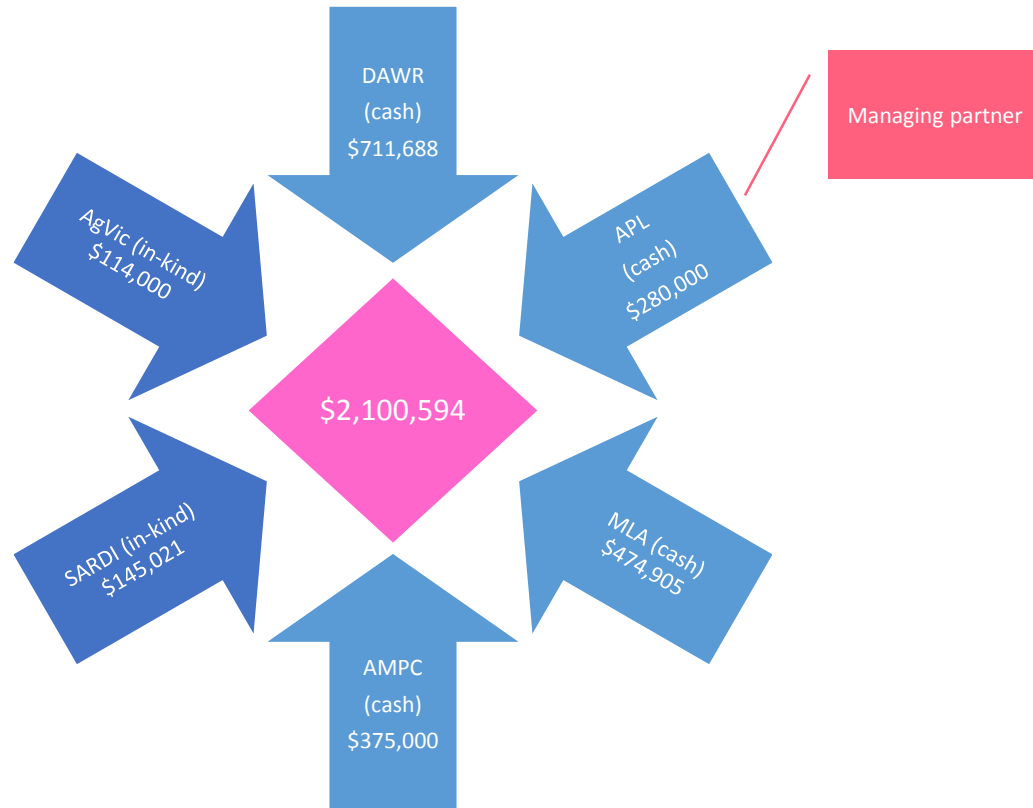

Health for Wealth

- The aim of the Project is to:
 - Introduce a standardised approach to collection of data on disease-related carcase and offal condemnations and trimming in abattoirs
 - Develop a standardised approach to providing this information back to producers



Health for Wealth Standards

- The Project will develop standards for consistent recording, reporting and analysis of disease-related offal and carcass condemn and trim data.
- The standards will be available for use by processors, producers, regulators and other key stakeholders.



Other Project Deliverables

- Business case(s) for data capture and reporting for stakeholders across the beef, goatmeat, pork and sheepmeat supply chains.
- Software modules to collect and consistently report the rate of disease-related carcass and offal condemnations and trimming.
